Bids are hereby invited for the appointment of a supplier for the FRASERBURG LANDFILL SITE - SUPPLY OF FENCING MATERIALS. The project entails the supply of fence materials in Fraserburg.

BID No **KHM T031/07/2020** must be placed in the tender box at the Karoo Hoogland Municipality, Supply Chain Management Unit/Front Entrance, 7 Mulder Street, WILLISTON, 8920 by no later than 12:00 on **21 August 2020**. Tenders will be opened on the same day in the Committee Room at 12:10. Late or unmarked tenders will not be considered. Formal tenders sealed and clearly marked with the Bid Nr. No posted tenders or tenders per fax or e-mail will be accepted. **Please ensure to complete the submission register at the Tender box. The submission register must be completed on behalf of the tendering company and not the details of courier companies. All Bids must remain valid for 90 days after the closing date of the tender.**

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender. If after 90 days no appointment has been made by the Municipality, the tender is cancelled automatically.

This tender is subject to Regulation 8 “Local Production and Content” of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2017: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 submitting of MBD 6.2 is compulsory. Local content requirement:

- 1. The exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South African Reserve Bank (SARB).**
- 2. Only the South African Bureau of Standards (SANS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 must be used to calculate local content.**

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT, 2000: PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017 AND the Karoo Hoogland Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, where 80 points will be scored for price and 20 points for B-BBEE status.

Important note: a valid original tax clearance certificate or tax compliance status verification pin and certified copies of directors and owners identities must be submitted with the documentation. All tenderers that take part in the tender must be registered on the Central Suppliers Database (CSD). Most recent CSD registration reports must be submitted. A current certified BBEE status level certificate must be submitted in order to claim preference points. Should there be any non-disclosure of conflict of interest; the contract will be deemed null and void.
