Tenders are hereby invited for the:

NEW SPORT FACILITY FOR SUTHERLAND – PHASE 2 (MIG 1307)

Completed tenders in a sealed envelope, clearly marked:

BID No KHM T004\2\2018\1 must be placed in the tender box at the Karoo Hoogland Municipality, Supply Chain Management Unit, 7 Mulder Street, WILLISTON, 8920 by no later than **12:00 on Friday, 23 March 2018**. Tenders will be opened on the same day in the Committee Room at 12:05. Late or unmarked tenders will not be considered. No posted tenders or tenders per fax or e-mail will be accepted.

It is estimated that the Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **5CE or higher for the Main Contractor and 3GB or higher for his subcontractor. A prerequisite of 75% exist for Functionality, in order to be further evaluated.** Tenderers will have to confirm similar experience in the construction of sport facilities specifically including items such as bulk earthworks, grassing, water pipes and ablution building structures in order to be eligible to tender.

A compulsory tender meeting with representatives of the employer will take place at the Karoo Hoogland Municipality Building, Nr 8 Northumberland Street, Sutherland, on Thursday, **15 March 2018** at 11:00. No tenderer will be allowed to join the meeting after it started at 11:00.

Documents will only be available if tenderers booked their tender documents and provided proof of payment in advance 2 days before the tender meeting.

The tender consists of the construction of **the second phase** of a new **sport facility in Sutherland**. The scope of works entail bulk earthworks, grassing, water pipes and the construction of an ablution building structure.

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT, 2000: PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017 and the Karoo Hoogland Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, where 80 points will be scored for price and 20 points for B-BBEE status.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to readvertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender. If after 90 days no appointment has been made by die Municipality, the tender is cancelled automatically.

All tenderers that take part in the tender process must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).
