# Other projects EPIP Funding cycle 2017

- Funding cycle application requested: 2017
  - Briefings conducted with all municipalities ( All municipalities attended)
  - All municipalities were visited to do online application
  - Project application for projects of budget of minimum of R 2.5
  - A total of 37 applications (includes YES and Mass Training) were submitted in most of the focus areas for environment and culture sector:
    - Working for the coast
    - Working for land
    - Greening and open space management
    - Youth environmental services
    - People and parks
  - Approvals will only be communicated end May 2018/ beginning June 2018
- List of applications include the following projects:
  - Nama Khoi Upgrading of existing recreational parks
  - Nama Khoi Kleinzee beachfront development
  - Nama Khoi land rehabilitation and restoration
  - Kamiesberg Establishment of new and upgrading existing recreational parks
